RadMD makes things easy for you.

RadMD is a user-friendly, real-time tool that provides ordering and rendering providers with instant access to prior authorization requests for specialty procedures. Whether submitting exam requests or checking the status of prior authorization requests, providers will find RadMD to be an efficient, easy-to-navigate resource.

BENEFITS OF RADMD ACCESS

Both ordering and rendering providers can access a range of online tools and resources on RadMD:

- Secure access to protect your data and your patients' protected health information (PHI).
- Up-to-the-hour authorization information, including:
 - · Date request initiated
 - Date exam approved
 - Authorization validity period
 - Valid billing codes (CPT®), and more
 - Evidence-based clinical review criteria via our Clinical Guidelines.

INFORMATION FOR ORDERING PROVIDERS

Ordering physicians have access to a number of important tools:

- Straightforward instructions for submitting procedure requests, including the ability to submit multiple requests in the same online session.
- Appropriate ICD-10 code lookup.
- Continuous updates on authorization status, which eliminates the need to get updates via phone.
- Fast authorization decisions available to you online.
- Ease of searching for and selecting convenient rendering providers

To get started, ordering providers should go to **RadMD.com**, click *New User* and submit an Application for a New Account. Your RadMD login information (username and password) should not be shared. This further protects PHI.

INFORMATION FOR RENDERING PROVIDERS

Rendering providers can also use RadMD to submit prior authorization requests, and quickly view pending, in-review and approved authorizations for their facility, ensuring prompt service for patients who require specialty procedures.

To get started, go to **RadMD.com**, click *New User* and submit an Application for a New Account.

If you are an imaging facility or hospital that performs exams, an administrator must be identified, as this is the person who will grant access to Taxpayer Identification Numbers (TINs). Your RadMD login information (username and password) should not be shared.
